

HOW TO REGISTER STUDENTS AT GREYSTONE COLLEGE:

English Test:

- Montréal and Toronto students should take the ILSC ACADEMIC English Placement Test which includes a written section and an interview.

PAYMENT PLAN

GENERAL RULES

- Available for Greystone programs with a minimum of 6 months academic study duration (not including co-op)
